

TOWN OF CLYDE BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
MARCH 13, 2007

**Meeting called to order:** 7:00 PM, March 13, 2007. Board members present: Jesse Gilbertson, Paul Cummings, David Price, Bonnie Mainwaring and Linda Kane.

**Minutes:** Minutes from the February meeting were read and approved. Motion made by Paul Cummings, seconded by David Price.

**Treasurer's Report:** Bonnie reported in regular checking \$48,910.30; GIP fund \$46,770.74; and Reserve for Capital \$13,535.76. Treasurer's report approved by Jesse, seconded by Paul. Jesse made a motion to move \$30,000.00 to GIP, seconded by Dave.

**Committee Reports:**

**Long Range Planning Commission – Smart Growth** – Jesse talked to Bob Dries about the pending driveway at the Michaels/Reynolds property. Once the driveway has been widened and inspected by Jesse the zoning application will be approved.

**Clyde Community Center Board** – The chili/chicken noodle soup dinner was a huge success. Dave wondered about selling tickets ahead to better plan for the event. This question will be addressed at the next CCC Board meeting.

**Roads:** Jesse instructed Matt to put up weight limit signs by Monday. As the town gears up for spraying Wild Mustard in the township Matt will need to take a commercial test. The township will be spraying for this weed during a two week period to be announced in the near future. Matt reported that the truck may need new chains for next year. Jesse instructed the guys to start brushing again. The town will look at getting a mower from Simpson Ford again this year. Dwayne wants a reflective vest to wear when clearing brush on town roads.

**Town Shop Site:** Jesse will be getting a bid from Pat Rogers for shingling the salt shed. He also wants to get a painter to paint salt shed.

**Dump:** Sign was reordered due to wrong colored lettering. Jeff Christianson will need Saturday, March 31<sup>st</sup> off. Matt will be filling in for him.

**Café:** Jesse conveyed some janitorial concerns with Dan. The entrance area needs to be kept clean and sidewalks free of snow. Dan mentioned that we need a new snow shovel. The heating situation in the café will be addressed early next week. The air conditioner will be removed soon and the wall fixed. Dan presented a bid for painting materials and labor for making some improvements in the Café. Dave made a motion to accept bid, seconded by Paul.

**Cemetery:** Nothing to report.

**Fire Dept. District Meeting & Billing Update:** No receipts to date. Clyde has received a new billing from Robbie Peco's fatal accident back in February.

**Old Business:** Charles Anderson questioned Jesse about where the Town was at with the Anderson Road maintenance agreement. Linda had sent a draft copy prepared by our town attorney, Tim McKinley to the Town of Highland for their

review. Clyde Township has not heard from them so Jesse will contact their town chairman.

**New Business:** Road bids need to be put in the paper for next month. Dave commented on the Board of Review training and Pacer meeting that he recently attended. A brief discussion took place regarding Board of Review and Open Book. We need to let Tom LeCleur they need to be held on two different days.
